The Brazilian Chess Federation for the Visually Impaired (FBXDV), with the endorsement of IBCA Americas, is pleased to extend the invitation for the Pan-American Chess Championship for the Blind and Visually Impaired IBCA 2026, to be held in the city of São Paulo, Brazil. The invitation is for all countries of the American continent represented by their National Federations or Chess Associations in the International Braille Chess Association (IBCA).

1. First Deadline

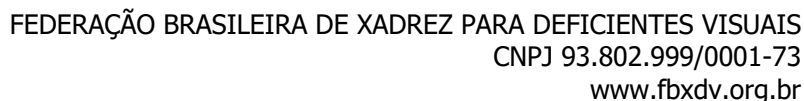
- **Intention to participate:** June 15, 2026.

2. Final Deadline

- **Completion of the registration form:** Until August 15, 2026. All medical and dietary restrictions must be indicated, as well as whether the participant is a wheelchair user.

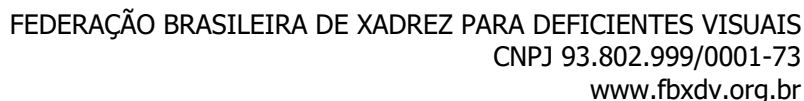

7. Registration Form

- The form is attached to this invitation. Players must have a FIDE identification (ID) from their respective national federations, which must be specified in the form.
- It must be clearly specified whether the player is blind or has low vision.
- The FBXDV reserves the right to refuse registrations that do not contain the FIDE identification number or the type of disability.

8. Eligibility to Participate

- Open to National Braille Chess Federations that are members of IBCA Americas, without financial pendencies. Federations in arrears must settle their debts by August 31, 2026.

- ## II. TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

Rua Vigário José Inácio, 263/54, Bairro Centro – CEP 90020-100 – Porto Alegre/RS



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- The championship will follow the FIDE Laws of Chess, the FIDE General Competition Regulations, the IBCA Rules, and these Technical Regulations. Unforeseen cases will be decided by the IBCA President.

2. Participation

- Open to all players representing Member Federations of IBCA Americas, with no limit on participants per federation.
- Players from countries without an associated federation can participate under the IBCA flag, upon prior request (secretary@ibca-info.org) and presentation of FIDE ID.
- Registrations must be made in bulk by an authorized representative of each delegation.

3. Format and System

- **Categories:** Blind (B1) and Visually Impaired (B2 and B3). For the B1 category, the use of a blindfold or occluders during matches is mandatory.
- **System:** Swiss, 7 rounds. Two matches per day (except on the fourth day, with only one round).
- Pairing via FIDE-certified software, using the September 2026 FIDE Standard Rating.

4. Time Control and Tolerance

- **Time Control:** 90 minutes for each player, with an increment of 30 seconds per move (Fischer Increment) starting from move 1 (90'+30").



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- **Tolerance:** Delays exceeding 30 minutes after the start of the round will result in a walkover (W.O.) loss.

5. Tiebreaks As per FIDE recommendations, the criteria will be:

1. Buchholz Cut 1
2. Buchholz
3. Sonneborn-Berger
4. Cumulative system (Sum of progressive scores)
5. Direct encounter
6. Greatest number of victories
7. Greatest number of victories with the black pieces

7. Player Conduct

- Mandatory use of the uniform of their respective delegation.
- Mandatory attendance at the Opening and Closing Ceremonies.
- Collaboration with the press for short interviews after matches.
- Maintain dignified appearance and posture according to the FIDE Handbook.

8. Fair Play and Electronic Equipment

- It is prohibited to carry unapproved electronic devices during the match (e.g., cell phones, smartphones, tablets, headphones, etc.). They can be kept in the player's bag (completely turned off) with the arbiter's permission.
- Audio move recording equipment is the only permitted exception.
- Companions and spectators cannot use electronics in the playing hall (except for photos with the arbiter's permission and without interfering with the competition's official communication).

9. Appeals Committee (Appeals)



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- Composed of members from different federations.
- Protests must be submitted in writing up to one (1) hour after the match/incident.
- Protest fee: US\$ 100 (refunded if the protest is accepted).
- The decisions of the Appeals Committee are final and unappealable.

10. Prizes

- Trophies for the top three in each absolute category (Blind and Visually Impaired), including the female category (Blind and Visually Impaired) and medals for the respective 4th and 5th places.
- Participation certificates for all players present.

11. Organizing Committee and Directors

- Composed of the President of IBCA Americas, Mr. Fernando Daza (Colombia), and the Technical Director of the Tournament, Mr. Vinícius Ricieri (Brazil), among others.
- The Chief Arbiter will be the President of the Appeals Committee.

Organization's Note: This championship represents a milestone for adapted chess in the Americas, reaffirming Brazil's commitment to inclusion, sports excellence, and integration among nations.
